#### THE OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (LEAFIELD PARISH) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\*

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of their powers under sections 82, 83 and 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Leafield Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 202\* and shall come into force on the day of 202\*.
- 2. The roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall not be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 4. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 5. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 6. The Oxfordshire County Council (Leafield Parish) (Speed Limits) Order 2001 is hereby revoked/replaced.
