Report – Pavilion – car damage insurance claim

OVERVIEW

The Pavilion was damaged by a car in 2021. The insurance company initially refused to allow repair work to be undertaken due to the subsidence claim.

The insurance company agreed in November 2023 that the car damage repair works can be carried out and requested a new estimate, as the previous one had been submitted in 2021.

A quotation has been obtained and sent to the insurance company.

On 19th February the Council received an email advising that the car damage repair works can be carried out – that the scope of works and the cost had been approved.

QUOTATIONS

A quotation was received from G & O Engineers (Building Services) Ltd. This has been approved by the insurer

Cost of works £3,100.95

(Note - PC has been advised that there will be a 3-4 week lead time for the new door)

COUNCIL DECISIONS

- To instruct G & O Engineers (Building Services) Ltd to carry out the repair works as agreed with the insurance company
- To suspend Financial Regulations regarding the number of quotes required for the works, as this contractor and cost has been approved by the insurance company
- To advise users of the Pavilion that repair works will be carried out, and areas of the Pavilion will be out of use during this time.
